

About us

Public Institution Computer Program Training Centre (*VsI Kompiuteriniu programu mokymo centras*) is a SME founded in 2000. The company is engaged in adult and vocational training. Centre train more than 1,000 people a year.

The institution offers a wide range of courses – formal and non-formal in computing, computer design, accountancy, business administration, business management, secretarial skills, basic enterprise skills, languages, law etc. We have a track record in VET training, knowledge and experience in organisation of VET training, and we are familiar with VET education practice and problems in Lithuania.

The aim of our institution is to provide vocational training to our learners in order to improve the employability skills of disadvantaged target groups who experience difficulties in integration to labour market. These groups include women returnees to the labour market, migrants, disabled, young people taking their first steps into employment and those living in rural areas and other socially isolated groups. We seek to increase employability of mentioned groups through the raising of self-motivation and self-confidence of learners using innovative pedagogical methodologies. Our teaching is based not only on theoretical knowledge, but on good practical examples, advice and training.

Recently training centre become active in the field of employability raising of disabled people through vocational training. Centre organised computer training for blind people and now is searching for further opportunities on the field of employability raising and training of people with mental illness or disability. Centre is planning to take part in other EU projects related to the development of integration system and methodologies of people with mental disability.
